Thursday, September 25, NCM held it's first Annual Partner's Breakfast for the Restoring Hope investors. Over 40 partners attended the breakfast to get an update of the progress of the Restoring Hope! programs.



The 3 components of the Restoring Hope! program included: 1) Transforming Lives, 2) New and Expanded Services and 3) Educate and Communicate.

Transforming Lives in Action...

The goal of Transforming Lives is to guide families from poverty to economic responsibility and teach life skills and workforce educations.

Our Transforming Live Program (TLP) has helped 9 families transition from homelessness to stable housing. Currently, we are also working with 5 more families to move into economic independence.

Restoring Hope! funds have allowed us to invest in new technology in order to provide life skills and workforce education courses in our **Training Annex**. For example, we use technology to help with resume preparation and job search strategies.



We have partnered with Associated Credit Union, Clearpoint and The Private Bank to offer budget and credit management classes.



We are now able to provide <u>all</u> clients with nonfood items such as toothpaste, shampoo, soap and deodorant. These items cannot be purchased with food stamps.

We now offer activities in our **Children's Annex** for kids while their parents are receiving services. We are in the <u>need</u> of volunteers to assist in this area. Please prayerfully consider helping.
