December of 2019, the Beyond the Building Campaign began. The purpose of this \$2.9M property acquisition and renovation was to enable NCM to be self-sustaining, expand both the number and breadth of services provided and to co-locate with other non-profit tenants who also serve our clients creating a one-stop shop for serving the community.

Thanks to the generosity of local individuals, families, businesses and foundations the \$2.9M Beyond the Building campaign has reached 93% of its goal. We look forward to raising another \$200,000 in 2021 exceeding the Beyond the Building campaign goal!

- We received numerous grants and financial contributions enabling us to almost eliminate the mortgage on our new building. We expect to fully pay it off in 2021!

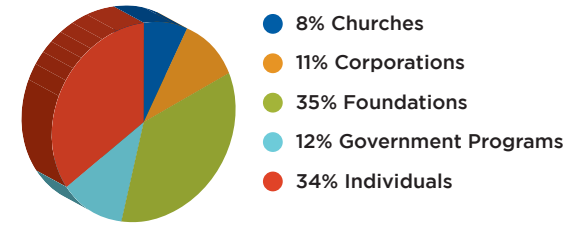
