# 2022 Annual Report



## Letter From Board of Directors President

As Covid waned in 2022, the need did not. Demand for services was up 34% as families struggled with record-setting inflation, rising rents, and the end of Covid support programs. Although donations were down slightly, they still enabled us to serve more people than ever before! We could not have done this without YOU! Thank you for entrusting us to serve those in need on your behalf.

In addition to serving over 25,000 individuals and distributing over \$1.6 million in aid, much more was accomplished. We

- Re-opened all of our ministries that had been side-lined during Covid.
- Started construction on a 4,144 sq. ft. expansion to triple the size of our clothing closet and add space for a new Starting Over Ministry to help families furnish new apartments with basic household items. These areas will be open by the end of Q1 and will also enable us to host larger volunteer groups.
- Moved closer to our vision of turning our building into a hub for a wider variety of client services with the addition of our first non-profit tenant: Hope Atlanta, providing rapid rehousing services.

In 2023, our primary focus will be on adding healthier food options for our clients through the addition of significant walk-in refrigerated and freezer storage. We are piloting a program with Rainbow Village to explore new and improved ways to help our clients on their journey to self-sufficiency. Lastly, we will add an Advisory Council as an additional resource for our Board. Thank you for being a difference maker through your continued support of NCM. So many have been helped because of your generosity this year.


