Letter From Board of Directors President

Significant inflation was the unfortunate continued trend in 2023. Food, rent, and utility costs were some of the areas hardest hit – all areas that tremendously impact our clients. However, thanks to our amazing donors and volunteers, NCM was in a strong position to help our clients weather the storm. The demand for our assistance continues to grow. We served over 27,000 individuals and distributed over **\$1 million** in aid throughout 2023. We also:

- Opened our new 4,000+ sq. ft. clothing closet. With this added space, we were able to distribute over 47,000 pieces of clothing (up 30% from last year).
- Kicked off our partnership with Rainbow Village to provide longer term and more in-depth support, training, and education for clients. We are extremely pleased with the life-changing results in the first year of this program, and we look forward to even more success in 2024.
- Purchased a refrigerated truck and neared completion of a 450 sq. ft. walk-in freezer/cooler.

As we look to 2024, one of our primary areas of focus will be to take full advantage of our new truck and food storage space. This will allow us to provide our clients with more fresh, healthy food options, and more choice in the food that meets the needs of their families. Achieving our full potential in this area will require new and expanded relationships with food providers as well as a significant increase in our number of volunteers and volunteer hours.

We are extremely grateful for all your support to date, and we look forward to the opportunity to partner with you again in 2024 to help meet the growing needs of our neighbors.


