Letter from our Leaders:

2025 brought its share of fear and uncertainty for many including the 46,000 neighbors who walked through our doors. Our community responded with excellence and grace as companies, neighborhoods and churches rallied together to join us in our mission to build a healthier community - physically, financially, socially, and spiritually.

Through partners like Concrete Jungle, we brought in thousands of pounds of fresh produce and offered education on how to use it. Our Crisis to Career campaign combined the strengths of NCM, Georgia Center for Opportunity, and Families First to help Gwinnett residents increase earnings while building long-term resilience for multiple generations. We continued to invest in the social and spiritual well-being of families through English classes, senior buddy meals, VBS, budget bootcamps and life skills classes.

Moving into 2026, we will focus like never before on leading our neighbors to the abundant life that God has planned for them by pointing them towards programs and resources leading to stability and resiliency. We plan to hire a Director of Development to ensure our supporters remain connected to our mission and a Nutrition Program Manager to transform food assistance into food empowerment. Construction is underway on our Community Learning Lab that will provide space for employment events, financial empowerment workshops, behavioral health services, education for kids and adults, Bible studies and more. Lastly, we will build upon 2025's successes like the 90% of Crisis to Career participants increasing resiliency and 73% keeping jobs after 6 months.

Thank you for all that you continue to do to help us bring about transformation in our neighborhood. With your help, we will continue to be calm in the chaos for our neighbors as we build a healthier and more resilient community.




